



## 2026 AAWE Scholars Award to attend CWE 2026 Call for Applications

The American Association for Wind Engineering is pleased to announce the 2026 AAWE Scholars Award support qualified students to attend CWE 2026 or 'The 8th International Symposium on Computational Wind Engineering'

### 2026 AAWE Scholars Award to attend CWE 2026

- Description: This award is to assist qualified graduate students who will attend and present their research at the upcoming 8th International Symposium on Computational Wind Engineering CWE 2026. <https://cwe2026.com/>
- Amount: The award will be in the form of a travel bursary equal to 550 USD (750 CAD), equal to the cost of the (early bird) registration fee to attend the CWE 2026 symposium.
- Number of Bursaries: Ten (10) Travel Bursaries will be awarded by a specially appointed committee who will review the application material.
  
- Requirements
  - The Applicant must be an AAWE student member in good standing for year 2026, must be the first author of the paper and present the work, as oral presentation, at CWE 2026.
  - The Applicant must submit the full conference paper by the deadline specified by the CWE organization (March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026). The paper must comply with the CWE submission guidelines, available on <https://cwe2026.com/submissions/>
  - The full paper must be on a topic related to Wind Engineering.
  - Priority will be given to (MS and PhD) graduate students. Postdoctoral student applications may be accepted, depending on total number of applicants.
  
- Application Instructions
  - Student Applicants should submit (1) a one-page cover letter (PDF), signed by the student's advisor, confirming the status of the first author as (a) main contributor to the work and (b) a full-time PhD or MS student, enrolled in an accredited university; (2) copy of the confirmation email by CWE 2026 Organization that the abstract (with ID number) was accepted for oral presentation; (3) a copy of the full conference paper accepted (or being submitted) to CWE 2026; and (4) a one-page resume/CV of the student applicant (indicating, in the header section, full legal name, designated email and postal address for conferral of the award).

  - Applications are due by **March 31st, 2026**
  
- Notification, Reimbursement and other Rules
  - Notification to the Awardees will be made by mid-April 2026.
  - After receiving award notification, the awardees will fill out a reimbursement (check) request form and subsequently receive the bursary in the form of a bank check from AAWE, payable to the student himself/herself (in USD currency). Please indicate, in the header of the resume/CV, full legal name and address where the check should be sent.
  - Awardees will be required to acknowledge the support of AAWE on the "Acknowledgments" slide of their CWE 2026 presentation. Please use the following statement: "The first author gratefully acknowledges the travel bursary support by the 2026 AAWE Scholars Award to Attend CWE 2026."
